

## **HON. BRIAN A. JACKSON**

Brian A. Jackson is a Federal Judge who serves on the U.S. District Court for the Middle District of Louisiana. Judge Jackson earned a bachelor's degree from Xavier University of Louisiana, a law degree from the Southern University Law Center and a master of laws degree from the Georgetown University Law Center. Judge Jackson served as an Associate Deputy Attorney General in the United States Department of Justice in Washington, DC and as a career federal prosecutor in the U.S. Attorneys Offices in Baton Rouge and New Orleans. Prior to his appointment to the federal bench, Judge Jackson was as a partner in the law firm of Liskow & Lewis where his practice focused on commercial litigation and white collar criminal defense. He took the oath of office as a member of the federal judiciary on June 18, 2010 and served as the Chief Judge of the District from June 2011 to June 2018. He is a Fellow of the American College of Trial Lawyers and a Member of the American Law Institute. He currently serves on the boards of the Baton Rouge General Hospital System and the Greater New Orleans Foundation, among others.
